O Que é o 6+ Hold'em? O 6+ Hold'em, também conhecido como Short Deck Hold'em, remove todas as cartas com valores menores que seis, resultando em um baralho de 36 cartas. O jogo segue regras semelhantes ao Texas Hold'em, no entanto, há algumas diferenças importantes.

Neste jogo, os ases são considerados a carta alta e podem completar a sequência baixa, o que significa que uma sequência como 3-6-7-8-9 agora é uma sequência para oito. Além disso, os jogadores recebem apenas duas cartas ocultas e devem combiná-las com as cinco cartas comunitárias disponíveis

no centro da mesa para formar a melhor mão de cinco cartas.
