

Odds Converter

Converting odds to percentages can help you make better decisions when betting on sports or other online games. In this article, we will explain step by step how to convert positive and negative odds to a percentage. Also, we will provide a simple formula for

calculating odds from probability.

Converting positive odds to a percentage

For positive odds, divide 100 by the value of the odds plus 100 and multiply the result by 100. For example, if the odds are 300, the calculation would be:

$$\left(\frac{100}{300 + 100}\right) \times 100 = 25\%$$

Converting negative odds to a percentage

For negative odds, divide 100 by the absolute value of the odds minus 100 and multiply the result by 100. For example, if the odds are -200, the calculation would be:
