Como funciona a borda da casa?

A borda da casa funciona inclinando as probabilidades roleta sorteio numeros favor do cassino. Por exemplo, num jogo como a roleta os chances de ganhar para o jogador são menores que os riscos e perdas - Isso significa também um lucro ao longo dos anos mesmo se ele ganha ocasionalmente; O limite é calculado com uma porcentagem menor ou igual a 1% até 10% mais alto no tempo!
