The name flamingo comes from Portuguese or Spanish flamenco ("flame-colored"), which in turn comes from Provenal flamenc a combination of flama ("flame") and a Germanic-like suffix -ing. The word may also have been influenced by the Spanish et hnonym flamenco ("Fleming" or "Flemish").
