The exclamation mark (**!**) is a punctuation mark. It is used to denote a strong feeling or a statement of surprise, emphasis, or warning. Other uses include: In mathematics, it denotes the factorial operation. Several computer languages use ! at the beginning of an expression to denote logical negation.
