What does Wanted Dead or Alive mean in Red Dead Redemption 2?

Red Dead Redemption 2's Wanted Dead or Alive system is designed to help players understand their status and how to deal with it. When a player is wanted, a red area will appear around them, indicating that they are being hunted. This area will expand as the player's wanted level increases. If the player is wanted, they will receive a bounty and a wanted level. The wanted level is a measure of how much the authorities want to see the player. A wanted level of 1 means the player is wanted in the area, while a wanted level of 3 means the player is wanted in the entire game world.
